The "chalking of the doors" is an ancient practice dating back hundreds of years, when people would write the date of the upcoming year above their doors with the letters C, M, and B tucked inside. If we were to do it today, it would look like the inscription above. Each letter stands for a Latin word. The "C" stands for "Christus", meaning "Christ". The "M" stands for "mansionem", meaning "house". And the letter "B" stands for

"benedicat", or "blessing". In other words, it's a prayer for the coming year: May Christ bless this house.

Today we stand at the beginning of 2019. God is doing a new thing in our church and in our homes, where we work and where we play, when we rise in the morning and when we go to bed at night. When you look back at last year, what new thing did God do in your life in 2018? When you look ahead to 2019, what new thing will God be doing in your life this coming year?

It's hard to predict the future – in fact, it's downright impossible! But there are practices we can do that help us prepare for what's to come. For instance, if we practice living in fear, then we'll probably be afraid most of the time, keeping our eyes closed, expecting the worst. But if we practice living in faith, then we'll probably be keeping our eyes open, walking tall, and discovering all the ways God is blessing us into a brighter future.

Heavenly Housekeepers


Thursday, January 24

Capital Campaign News

As we begin the new year, you will begin to hear a lot about Trinity's 2019 Capital Campaign. Here's a little recap of what it's all about.

In 2013, Trinity expanded its facility by adding elevators, air conditioning, office space, and a Gathering Hall to enhance our ministry in the community at a cost of about \$1.7 million. The intent was to pay off this amount with pledges from the congregation through three 3-year Capital Campaigns. In 2019, we'll begin our third 3-year campaign, where we hope to eliminate the final debt of around \$500,000. Trinity will be working with the consulting firm, KAIROS & Associates to help us with our third Capital Campaign.

As we celebrate what God is doing here at Trinity, we will also begin discussing other building and renovation projects that have been considered for the future. Watch for more details this month as we kick-off our 2019 Capital Campaign.


Pastoral Care

10 Healthy Snacking Tips



Happy New Year from the Parish Health Ministry team! Now that it's January, many of us are trying to return to our healthier eating habits, after enjoying endless delicious treats over the last month. Here are 10 healthy snacking tips to help get you back on track in the new year!

- 1. Make time to shop more often to keep healthy snacks (cheese, fruit, vegetables) fresh and available.
- **2.** Enjoy protein-rich foods such as nuts, hard-cooked eggs, cheese, or yogurt for long-lasting energy.
- Pair healthy foods with indulgent ones. Eat carrot sticks with a favorite dip or make a trail mix of nuts, dried fruit, and chocolate chips.
- Swap out less nutritious snacks gradually. Instead of a candy bar every afternoon, try fruit sorbet or frozen yogurt with nuts.
- **5.** If you are on the run, make a quick smoothie with frozen fruit, yogurt, and juice. Drink it on the road!
- **6.** Remember that snacks have calories too. Enjoy snacks but make your portions smaller than at mealtimes.
- Set a snack schedule, perhaps every three to four hours, to minimize mindless nibbling.
- **8.** Plan ahead. Eat a healthy snack before attending an event if "better-for-you" snacking options will not be available. Put out small portions of healthy snacks while watching TV.
- 9. Make sure you have a way to keep perishable items cold. Pack foods in an insulated lunch bag with a small ice pack, or freeze foods that will be cool but thawed by snack time.
- **10.** Make snacks fun by chopping colorful fruits and vegetables into small portions or using cookie cutters to cut sandwiches into different shapes.
